WHO CAN REGISTER?

- CLB Level 5 and up
- Essential Skills Numeracy Level 4
- Referred by a WorkBC Centre with an Action Plan
- PR, Citizen, Protected Refugee (with court's decision)
- Currently receiving Employment Insurance (EI) benefits or Reach back, have had an EI Benefit within the previous 60 months, or have earned more than \$2,000 in insurable earnings and have paid Employee EI premiums on those earnings in at least 5 of the last 10 years. (Note: the 5 years do not have to be consecutive years)
