- minimum age: 15 years and above;
- compassionate and patient demeanor;
- creative and shows initiative;
- excellent interpersonal and communication skills;
- ability to work effectively with diverse populations, including seniors from different cultural backgrounds; and
- commitment to volunteering a minimum of 100 hours over a long period of time.
